Please read these instructions before completing the application for guest admission.

- The purpose of guest admission is to serve two types of students:
 - Students interested in taking courses at Wayne State University for one semester, after which they will return to their current institution.
 - Students attending another accredited institution who wish to register concurrently for courses at Wayne State University.
- These are the requirements for admission as a WSU guest student:
 - Students must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours at their current institution.
 - Students must be enrolled in the current academic year at an accredited institution, be in good standing and eligible to return.
 - Students must have a minimum cumulative "C" average (GPA = 2.0) or better. Students on academic probation are not admissible.

To verify that you meet the admission requirements to be a WSU guest student, the registrar's office at your current institution must complete the box at the top of this page.
- Guest admission is for the semester in which it is issued. You may register for one additional, consecutive semester by completing another guest application (front side only).**
- You may register for classes in which you have completed appropriate prerequisites. Courses within certain professional programs at WSU may not be open to guest students. It is up to the academic departments to determine whether guest students are permitted to take courses within certain professional programs.
- A \$30 (\$50 for international students) nonrefundable application fee, paid by check or money order, made payable to "Wayne State University," must be returned with this application. Checks drawn on Canadian or other foreign banks should carry the notation, "Payable in US funds, plus service charges."
- Admission as a guest student is not a guarantee of admission at a later date. While not required for guest admission, non-native English speakers are required to present the following test scores for transfer admission consideration: 550 paper-based or 213 computer-based TOEFL; IBT score of 79; 5.5 TWE; and 5.5 Oral Proficiency. Test results cannot be more than two years old. Permanent residents who have graduated from US high schools are not required to show proof of English Proficiency. Visit admissions.wayne.edu for transfer student English Proficiency exemptions.
- If you intend to transfer WSU credits completed as a guest student to your current institution, it is recommended that you check with your college advisor about whether the credits are transferable. To have your WSU transcript sent to your home institution, contact the WSU Office of Student Records at (313) 577-3531.
- Financial Aid is NOT available with a guest admission.
