Tuition:	\$8,000
Living Expenses:	\$10,804

## Commuting Canadians

*Applicable to Ontario residents who are Canadian citizens*

Tuition:	\$8,000
Living Expenses:	\$2,000
<b>Total:</b>	<b>\$10,000*</b>

## Expenses for International Students

Tuition:	\$17,346
Living Expenses:	\$10,804
<b>Total:</b>	<b>\$28,150*</b>

\* EFFECTIVE DATE: August 1, 2009 (fees are subject to change by action of the university's Board of Governors)
